New Build - Daycare Centre

- 6 classroom walls currently framed
- Air Quality test done in school no concerns
- Roof will be tarred outside of school hours
 - Unsure of whether this is before/after school or during break (ie March Break; Easter Weekend; May long weekend etc.)

Fundraising

- Mom's pantry fundraiser a success raised \$977
 - Was able to purchase more Chrome Books for the school
- Discussed possible fundraiser for cellphone holders (purchase price \$1 each sell for \$5)
 - o Could be gift for graduating class
- Dance-A-Thon Friday, March 8th
 - o Pledge forms are available in classrooms school can accept cash donations
 - All students will get one entry into prizes
 - Students who fundraise will get one additional entry for every \$5 raised

- There will also be a door prize for students who attend Dance-A-Thon
- Discussed possible fundraiser with Blacksheep Coffee will sell at wholesale price
- Discussed possible fundraiser with Mabel's Labels Jessica to set up
- Play structure
 - Currently need to fundraise to maintain primary play structure, as it needs extensive repairs (\$15K for repairs – hoping to get done to reopen in Spring)
- Other Needs

 - Discussed possibility of reaching out to DSBN to see about old systems at GSS and BSS
 - o Basketball nets to be mounted on side of school galvanized hoops have been ordered
 - Thoughts about insert to put in them?
 - Still looking at replacing the courts that were taken down
